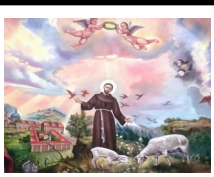

**Answer to last week's question about the Breastplate of St. Patrick:** According to tradition, St. Patrick wrote it in 433 A.D. for divine protection before converting the Irish King Leoghaire and his subjects. Although scholarship suggests an anonymous author, the prayer certainly reflects St. Patrick's spirit. The **Breastplate**, also is known as **The Lorica of Saint Patrick**, a hymn inspired by the text.
