~ *Pastor's Note* ~

I know this reflection on our recent Vacation Bible Camp (VBC) which was held the week of June 27th - July 1st, is late. The bulletin for that weekend had to be submitted early because of a earlier publication deadline due to the 4th of July holiday but I want to express how impressed I was with our VBC.

Our VBC theme this year was **“Food Truck Party”** and was centered on how God feeds us and how we, in turn, we are to feed one another. The beginning skit each day was built around a large cardboard cut-out of a food truck, which the children could relate, and the owner of the food truck learning the business of owning and running a food truck. The theme of food was then developed around bible stories of God in the Old Testament and Jesus in the New Testament feeding people. For example, one day the story was the account of Jesus feeding the 5,000 men, not to mention the addition of women and children, with loaves of bread and fish (**Mt. 14: vs 13 - 21**).

Each day the children were asked to bring a box of food, such as cereal or pancake mix to feed people locally who are hungry. Through out each evening of VBC the 120 children who attended moved from one activity, such as making crafts, to another activity, such as various outdoor games.

Countless hours of planning and decorating preceded the actual week of VBC. Seminarian Pascal Atunzu and I joined the adults and teenagers who accompanied the children during the week. I thank Dodie Seppi, our Director of Religious Education, Sandy Kaiser and Beth Supple, who both work in our Religious Education Office, and all the folks, who are too numerous to name, who made our VBC such a wonderful week this year! No doubt, the 120 children who participated join me in looking forward to our 2023 VBC!

We held a Blood Drive here at Holy Family on Friday, July 15th. The Blood Drive was the first one we have had since the Pandemic began and was sponsored by our own South County Knights of Columbus Council #8251. Donors gave blood here in the Anne Arundel Medical Center (AAMC) Bloodmobile. Twenty-six pints of blood were collected and we were told by the staff members of AAMC that it was the most successful Blood Drive that they have held since Covid began. Thanks to my Brother Knights for their work at the Blood Drive and to the donors who made time to donate their blood. We are planning another Blood Drive this Fall.

**DEACON DOUG'S Q & A:** The Church divides relics of saints into how many classifications?

**Answer to the question about sacraments and sacramentals:**

Sacraments were instituted by Jesus Christ to give grace of themselves. Sacramentals have been by the Church excite in us pious dispositions. An example of a sacrament is Baptism; in baptism the visible sign of washing with water is a visible sign of grace and the instrument of spiritual cleansing from sin. Sacramentals were instituted by the Church over time, and include blessings of persons, meals, objects, and places in Christ's name, accompanied by the sign of the cross. They do not have a divine origin, nor are they effected by Christ's direct action, but they do serve to make more aware of Christ's presence in our lives.
