The Sixteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time

Introduction:

A good shepherd always puts the needs of his flock first.

Today we hear how Jesus, the Good Shepherd, put the needs of others before his own.



OPENING PRAYER Light a Candle and have the children

listen to these words.:



The candle flame is warm and bright;

It changes darkness into light.

We feel its warmth and see its glow;

And when we look at it we know,

The light of Christ is burning bright

For we are children of the light.

GOSPEL:
MARK 6:30-34

After preaching to the people and curing many that were sick, the apostles returned to Jesus and told them everything they had said and done. As usual, crowds of people had followed them; the apostles were feeling tired and in need of a rest. Jesus said to them, “We will go somewhere quiet and spend some time alone.”

When Jesus and his friends arrived, however, a crowd of people had already gathered to meet them. When Jesus saw them, he was filled with pity because they were like sheep without a shepherd to care for them. He sat down on the hillside and began to teach them.

Wherever Jesus traveled, news soon reached the local people, and it was not long before a crowd of people flocked to him./ How would you feel?

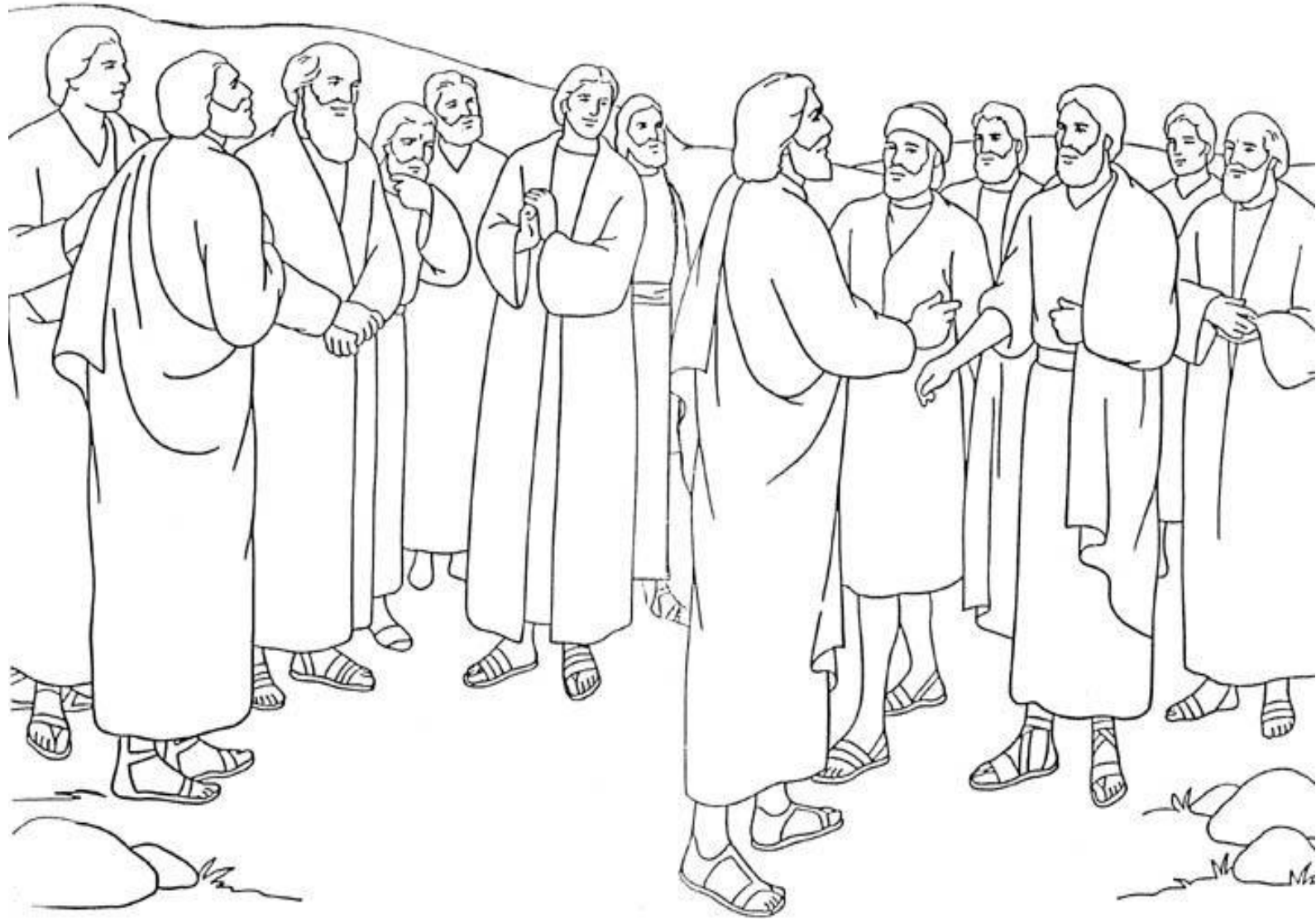
Jesus did not grow impatient or angry with the people. He felt a deep sense of love for them. He would never let them down or turn them away.
