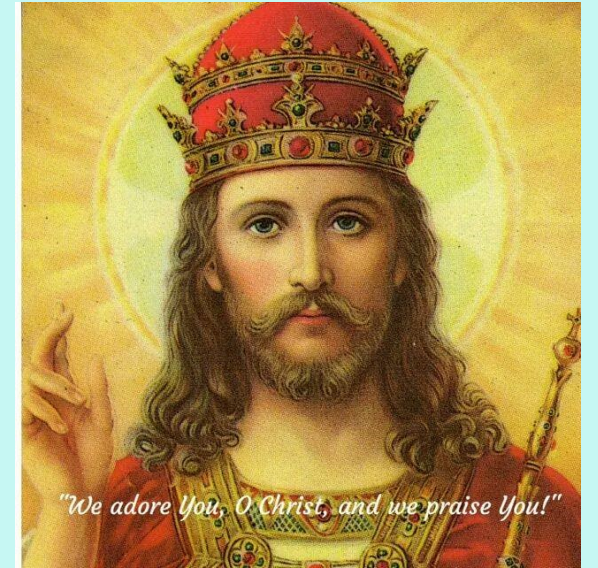

The Feast of Christ the King

Introduction:

Today is the last Sunday of the church's year, the feast of Christ the King. As the year draws to an end, we turn our thoughts to the time when Christ will return as king.



OPENING PRAYER



Light a Candle and say this together:

May the light of Jesus shine in our lives.

GOSPEL:

MATTHEW 25:31-46

Jesus told his disciples: “One day I will return in glory to sort the good people from the bad, and I will turn to you and say: When I was hungry, you fed me. When I was thirsty, you gave me drink. When you did not know me, you made me welcome. When I had nothing to wear, you gave me clothes. When I was ill, you took care of me. When I was alone, you came to visit me. And you will ask, ‘When did I do all these things for you, Lord?’

I tell you, whenever you did any of these things for others, you did them for me; and because of your goodness you will share in the glory of my kingdom. Those people who turned others away and did not care, did the same to me. On judgment day they will be sent away, never to share eternal life with me in heaven.”



Discussion

When Jesus comes back how will he sort the good people from the bad?

How can we make sure that we are sorted with the good people on judgement day?

Jesus knows each one of us better than we know ourselves, even down to the number of hairs on our head! He will sort out the good people from the bad, according to the lives they have led.

No one is good all the time, but we can make our loving actions outweigh the unloving ones.
