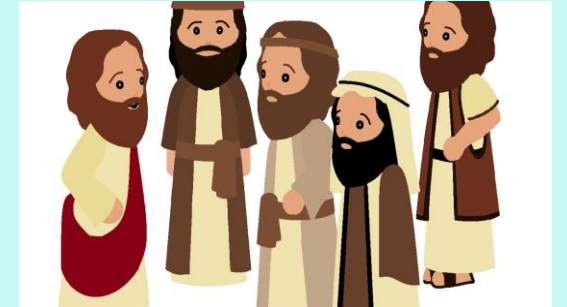

The Twenty-Fifth Sunday of Ordinary Time



Introduction:

Not everyone comes to know Jesus early in their lives, for some it might happen only at the end of a lifetime. But Jesus is loving and generous, and today we learn that those who follow him will receive the same reward at the end of time: everlasting life.

OPENING PRAYER



Light a Candle and have the children say
the following :


As we look at the brightness of the candle flames and prepare to listen to God's word, we remember the words of Psalm 119:

Your word Lord is a light for my path, a lamp to guide me closer to you.

GOSPEL:

MATTHEW 20:1-15

Jesus said to his disciples, “Early one morning the owner of a vineyard went to hire some men to work for him. He agreed to pay each of them one dollar per day. Late that afternoon he saw some other men who had not worked all day because no one had hired them. He sent them to his vineyard, too, and they set to work for him. At the end of the day, he paid each of the workers one dollar as he had promised. Some of them began to grumble. ‘Why have you paid these men the same as us, when we have worked all day in the hot sun, and they have only worked an hour?’ they said. The owner of the vineyard answered, ‘We agreed that each of you would be paid one dollar per day, and I have been fair. I can choose how to spend my money, so don’t complain because I have been generous.’”





Discussion

How much did the owner of the vineyard agree to pay his workers?

One dollar for the day.

At the end of the day's work, why did some of them grumble?

They felt that it was unfair of the owner to pay the same amount to all of them, when some had worked longer and harder than others.

(Pause to give your child time to pray)

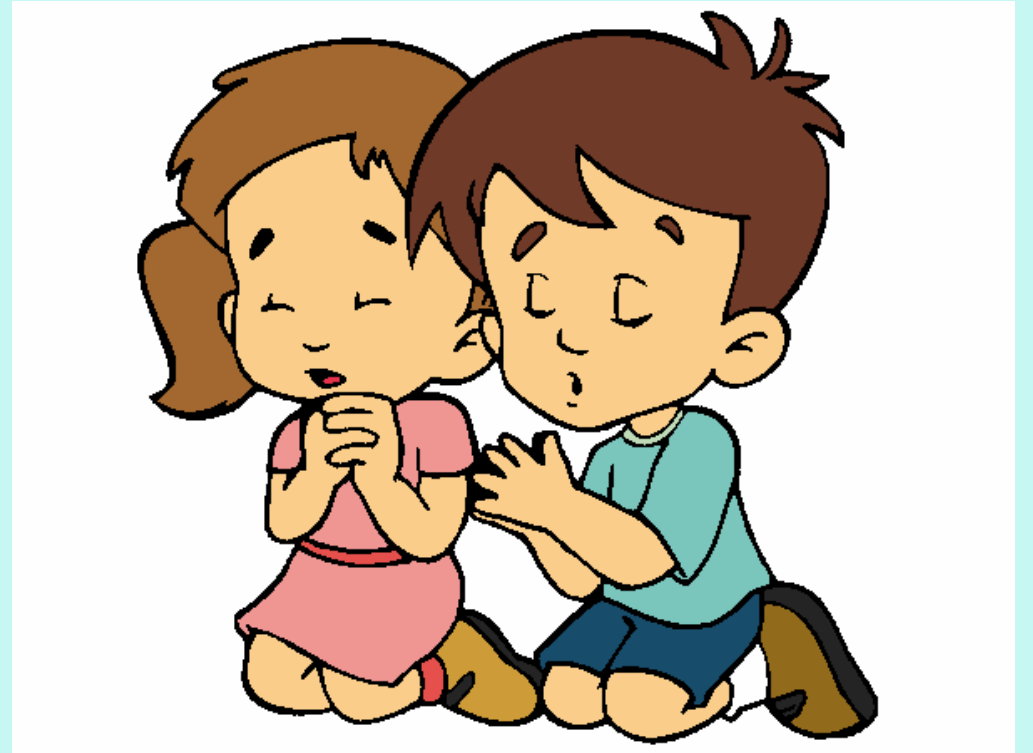
We pray to the Lord.
