Dear Parents/Guardians,

As has been true of every other Confirmation Class, the amount of things to be done exceeds the number of Church employees. As such, we need your help. Note well, we are not asking **if** you can help, but rather **how** you would like to help. Please indicate below:

_____ We will need six parents to help with crowd control for each of our large group sessions on **May 8th, 15th, and 22nd**.

_____ At least ten parents will be needed on the Confirmation Overnight Retreat. There will be two retreats on two weekends to accommodate our large class. The dates are **July 16th – 17th** and **July 30th – 31st**. We will leave Friday afternoon and return Saturday evening. We will need twenty parents in all.

_____ There will be 10 – 12 small groups, where Confirmation material is covered in catechists' homes. Each class will need 2 volunteers.

_____ We will take an educational trip to the National Shrine and eight parents will be needed to help chaperone.

The Holy Family Confirmation program has always been proud of the level of parental involvement and we ask that you strongly consider helping out. It doesn't always require having an extensive knowledge of the faith or giving up tremendous periods of time. Thank you so much for lending a hand.
