VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

"If you do this for the least of these you have done it unto me"

Our Religious Education program relies on volunteers providing their time and efforts in many ways. Read the descriptions of opportunities listed below. Write in any special talents that you have that you would like to share with our program.

Catechist: approximately 30 sessions, workshops and preparation, September-May. The teacher's manual provides you with all the lesson plans. Indicate grade level.

Co-catechist: Teach weekly classes with another catechist. Indicate grade level.

Aide: Assist catechist with weekly classes. Indicate grade level.

Substitute: Called to fill in for catechists. Indicate grade level.

Supply Help: Assists during the week by sharpening pencils, checking classroom supplies, make copies, etc.

Nursery Room Helper: assists in the nursery during a Mass one Sunday a month.

Liturgy of the Word for Children: Leaders and aides needed to cover Sunday discussions and activities with children attending Mass. One Sunday a month.

Facilitator: Help with High School program (10-12th grades).

Ministry of Mothers Sharing: This group needs prayer partners, babysitters, and facilitators as well as attendees. It meets on Tuesdays during the Fall and Spring.

Eucharist Catechist: 6 sessions, plus preparation, February – March.

Reconciliation Catechist: 6 sessions, plus preparation, October – November.

Faithful Friend: Provides one-on-one aid in classroom to students with special needs.

Driver/chaperone: for youth activity or gathering; can be a one-time, occasional or continual commitment.

Religious Education Committee Member: We meet the 1st Wednesday at 9:30a.m. for 1 hour at church. (October, November, December, February, March, and April)

Social Justice Committee: Organizing practical applications of the principles of Catholic social teaching (taking shoeboxes to drop-off point; driving groceries to Lighthouse Shelter in Annapolis)

Bake Sale Helpers: 4 times a year (10/10, 11/7, 2/13, 3/6) manning the tables and selling baked goods.

Processing & Deadlines:

- Religious Ed registration forms will be processed for **Registered Holy Family Parishioners only.** (To register with the parish call 301-261-7399.)
- All registrations due Saturday, July 31, 2010.** We cannot guarantee your first choice if we receive it past the due date.
- Registrations are processed in the order received when accompanied by payment.
- Only register for the session you can commit your child to attend the entire year. Changes mid-year will not be made for sports schedules.

Fees:

- Fees are: **\$100** for one child
\$175 for two children
\$225 for three or more children
\$60.00 for grades 10th, 11th & 12th (*if only signing up this grade*)
- Make checks payable to **Holy Family Catholic Church.** Include with registration.
- No family should neglect registration due to financial difficulties. You must indicate to the Religious Education Director that you have a financial situation in order for your registration to be processed without full payment.
- Fees are waived for families of adults who volunteer as Catechists or Co-Catechists.

If you have not taught in the past three years, we ask that you prayerfully consider being a catechist. Training will be provided.

SAM1, SAM2, SPM3, and MPM4 begin in September and finish in May.

HSS6 High School - grades 10, 11, and 12. Meets six Sundays between October and March. Class meets the 2nd Sunday of each month. This is a post Confirmation commitment.

Home Centered Instruction has four mandatory classes throughout the year. All classes must be attended by the student and the parent responsible for teaching. Books are checked for progress and an activity is done.

MSS8 Middle School – grades 6, 7, and 8. (August 10-13) A parent must volunteer to teach a few hours in order to enroll their middle school student. The student will also be required to attend 1 night of the Parish Mission (Nov. 14-17), and 1 night of Stations of the Cross during Lent.

*** Pre-K students must be 4 years old by 9-1-10**

Sacramental Life

The immediate preparation for Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation is required **in addition to** the regularly scheduled religion sessions. The Archdiocese requires a young person's weekly participation in a Religious Education Program **the year prior to** and **the year of** preparation. That is, in order to receive a sacrament this year, a young person would need to have been enrolled in a catholic school or attended religious education sessions both last year and this year as well.

Sacramental preparation is done by request, not by grade level. Sacraments are received in the home parish. Young people attending catholic schools are asked to register using this form and will receive an application for individual sacraments later.
