## HOLY FAMILY

*Dear Friends,*

This weekend is Pentecost, and on this weekend we remember how the Holy Spirit has come among us as Christians after Jesus returned to the Father. Indeed, in John 16, Jesus says that it is **“better”** for Him to go to the Father (in the Ascension), **SO THAT THEN** the Holy Spirit can come among us to guide us.

This weekend we have **WITNESS SPEAKERS** to talk about how members of our parish, through a Lent and Easter Season program, have come to get more in-touch with the Holy Spirit to guide their lives.

Having said that, it is also good to remember how Jesus wanted us to be part of a united Church that would be guided by the Holy Spirit too. In John 20, Jesus breathes the Holy Spirit upon the apostles in a special way and asks that they be guided to lead the Church with the help of the Spirit of God. It has always seemed to me, very significant that Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit descended upon the early Christians, happened when the early followers of Jesus were **“all gathered in one place”** that is, **UNITED**.

So, it would seem to me to be a balancing act. To have that personal guidance from the Holy Spirit through prayer and our faith life and also to have the humility to look to the Church as well. Then again, for the leaders of the **CHURCH** to be humble as well so as not to discourage the members of the Church and their attempt to trust in the **“Barque,”** or ship, of Peter.

Maybe a model for how our guidance by the Holy Spirit should operate in our lives might be offered by the humble St. Francis of Assisi who certainly had many private revelations of a very profound nature from God but who also attempted to be part of the Church of Peter.

The story I am thinking of involves an episode where the local Bishop in Assisi, at one point, banned Francis' group for being too extreme. Francis, who already had some private revelations from Christ to do his work, still, with great humility, went to Rome to talk to the Pope about this. When he arrived, bedraggled and dressed in rags with his followers, humbly asking the Pope for his advice, it turns out the Pope at the time had a dream the night before in which he saw a man holding up St. Peter's Church, keeping it from falling down and collapsing. Now meeting Francis he saw that Francis' face was the same one as the man in the dream who was saving the Church. **So Francis got permission to continue his work!!**

With that the history of the Church would **ALWAYS** be filled with such edifying stories, but I do believe that when we strive to follow Jesus and the Church He gave us with humility, we will be doing our part to build up our Church in our own time.

Next weekend, we will have a special blessing of all ministries in the parish during Mass. Thank you to all who are involved in helping our community to grow in faith and service. Let's all pray about how God might want us to use our own gifts to build up the Church.


