This weekend we hear about Mercy in some very shocking ways from Scripture. I'll focus on the first reading, from 2nd Samuel in the Old Testament. This is where King David is chastised by the Lord through the Prophet Nathan for purposefully putting a man into the front line of a battle for the specific reason of getting him killed so that he could take the man's wife, whom he liked and wanted for his own.

Such an extreme case, and God is strong with David, but then again, God has David continue to be the King of Israel, and, essentially, God doesn't "**throw David out**."

How many times have I thought of this reading in the context of the confessional, where I hear someone wonder whether God can forgive them or not for a sin? For the story of David tells us that God is always ready to walk with us, all we need to do is to be honest and to repent. Let's not stay away from Church or from God because we feel we "**aren't worthy**." This would only compound the damage done by our sin. It would block us from doing **GOOD** in the world to counteract the bad done by our misdeeds or our lack of action in the past in some way.

So, let us be serious about repenting, but let us also know that God wants to welcome us home, and to embrace us in the walk of life.

ENVIRONMENTAL MINISTRY NEWS:

Holy Family received a grant for native Trees and Shrubs from Unity Gardens. They were planted on May 14th by a dozen of our loving parishioners by the Chapel and at the recently cleared invasive forest edge behind the Post Office. Last fall Interfaith Partners of the Chesapeake provide 60 trees that were planted at the rear of the property. The Environmental Ministry is looking for your help by adopting a tree or shrub of your choice. This is a great opportunity for the kids to get involved. We planted Serviceberry, Pepperbush, Black Haw Viburnum, Red Maple, Dogwoods, High Blueberry, Witch Hazel, Button Bush, Elderberry, and Butterfly Bush. All plants are native to Maryland and specifically wildlife supportive. Families are invited to adopt a tree or shrub. We will put your family's name on the tag so you can always find them. You need to water them in the summer when it has not rained in a week. A milk jug will do. I will send you an email reminder. **Empty Nest Syndrome...adopt a tree or bush!**


