Dear Brothers and Sisters,
February 2nd & 3rd

This weekend we have the Super Bowl, quite the extravaganza. I always enjoy watching the game and even the ads (Doritos ads usually are my favorite). So, I hope everyone has a good time watching the game....which, for people like myself, is part of the spice of life – the annual Super Bowl Party, something for which to look forward to!

Having said that, let's remember our faith tells us that we'll find the greatest meaning **NOT** in the extravaganzas or the entertainments of this world....like 3 million tons of confetti and 200 synchronized dancers, 100,000 glow sticks in all different colors in the crowd, the money....(\$5 million for a 30 second ad), \$\$ Travis Scott and Maroon 5 will get for the halftime show and then the players themselves....and the whole big enterprise. Like most entertainment events in our nation today....a lot of cash is needed.

So, not to be a downer, but this "**big event**" would be a good time to remember that the most important things in life can't be purchases. Like The Beatles used to say, "Can't Buy Me Love." Sorry young adults for being so old and using old references but the lesson that real joy in this life can't be purchased is one that going to Mass, practicing our faith, praying and reading what Jesus said through studying the Bible can teach us.....

Mass is not flashy. 


