

# DEACON DOUG'S Q & A



**QUESTION:** What are the theme and message of our stained-glass windows?

Answer to the question: what does the word Pentecost mean? For Christians, it means the Descent of the Holy Spirit on the apostles and

the Birthday of the Church. The word itself, however, refers to the major Jewish festival of Shavuot, the thanksgiving for the first fruits of the wheat harvest, celebrated on the fiftieth day after Passover. It is also known as the "Feast of Weeks" and the "Feast of 50 days." "Pentecost" is the Greek translation, meaning 50th.
