**HOLY FAMILY**

*Dear Brothers and Sisters,*

*June 8th & 9th*

This weekend we celebrate Pentecost Sunday. On this day we remember the gift of the Holy Spirit to the Church. Of course, today we see that gift exhibited in extraordinary ways with fire above the disciple's heads and their speaking in languages which they should not have known, so that visitors from far-away places were remarking that the disciples were speaking their languages....which they should not have been able to know.

So, what can we learn from looking at that Pentecost event, from the Bible (Acts of the Apostles, Chapter 2)?

**a.** First that it happened when **"all"** of the disciples "were gathered in one place" (Acts 2, verse 2) **SO:** That was a sign that the Holy Spirit was a gift to the **WHOLE CHURCH** – not just to an individual for their own individual issues (though we do ask the Holy Spirit to help us individually). But, the Holy Spirit is also meant to **HELP US AS A COMMUNITY.**

**b.** The issue of the languages being spoken by the apostles seems to tell us, secondly, that the Holy Spirit is meant to help us to come together as **ONE**, even though we are very different – whether those differences are in language or culture or color or ethnic background or our own take on issues in our society.

It is, indeed, a point of pride for myself that our Catholic faith really does cross the divides in our world even today. That our Church is represented in so many nations, and that our U.S. Church is so diverse....and, in terms of our politically divided nation, that Catholic teaching is **CONSISTENT** in standing up for the vulnerable – whether that teaching is considered **"rightwing"** or **"leftwing"** in modern America.

Indeed, for all the opinions about the Church out there by folks, I have always thought that, deep down, the Catholic expression of Christianity is a very radical one in our modern time. One that, if we take Jesus seriously, and if we follow the paths of the saints, will lead us to a very counter-cultural place – because to value each person, and to overcome the barriers between people today in so many ways – this **IS** very counter-cultural. **I GUESS THAT'S THE HOLY SPIRIT.**

**Answer:** "Pentecost" is Greek for 50<sup>th</sup>. The disciples were gathered in Jerusalem on the first Jewish feast after Passover, which was fifty days later. Originally a Jewish feast to celebrate the first fruits of harvest, it became a feast to commemorate the Lord's revelation of the Torah to Moses on Mount Sinai. The coming of the Holy Spirit, promised by Christ, can possibly be seen as the "first fruits" of Christ's life, passion, death and resurrection. Pentecost brings to a close the Fifty Days of the Easter Season.




