## HOLY FAMILY



"Whatever town you enter and they welcome you, eat what is set before you, cure the sick in it and say to them, 'The kingdom of God is at hand for you.'"  
Lk 10:8-9

*Dear Friends,*

I am reading a couple of books right now. Sherry Waddell's book ***Forming Intentional Disciples***, and Fr. James Mallon's ***Divine Renovation***.

Ms. Waddell's book stresses that for a long time the cutting edge effort to "renew" the Church focused on better materials to teach about our faith. The concern was that maybe we had given people inadequate teaching and that if we just had the best presentation of the teachings of our faith, this would renew our Church.

Fr. Mallon's book says that same thing. He was ordained during the time of St. John Paul II and he said that the thinking of he and his young priest friends, years back, was that if young priests were holy enough and were giving good, solid, orthodox teaching, that this would renew the Church.

Well, good, orthodox Catholic teaching is essential and good materials that offer people a real understanding of their faith is essential. But both of these writers came up with the same critique. Nowadays, **BEFORE** we teach people anything, people have to win them over. That even before talking about Jesus, sometimes we have to gain the trust of a person who may be "against" "organized religion" or "institutions" or Christianity through our kindness, our integrity and our goodness. As Waddell writes, "Someone may not yet trust the Church, but they may trust you....you are the bridge."

If a person **IS** ready to hear about Jesus, we can't start with an explanation of the Mass if they don't even know Jesus in a personal way. We may have to work hard to help them to fall in love with Jesus before we talk about all of our Church teachings. Mallon basically says that we need to constantly be telling the basic story of Jesus and what his birth, teaching, suffering, death, resurrection and gift of the Church and the Holy Spirit to us all mean because people today aren't always totally converted to that in a personal way yet.

As one parish worker was quoted as saying about her program for teaching about the Catholic faith. The first half of the year I get them to fall in love with Jesus, the second half of the year I work to get them to fall in love with the Church.

So, Fr. Mallon and Ms. Waddell talk about having programs where people can be introduced to the basics of knowing Jesus and having faith and learning how to pray in our parishes and also that we would always work to create ways for people to get to know one another and to build up a sense of family in the parish.

Fr. Mallon wrote about a number of ways they tried to bring a sense of family to the Mass and even the Mass experience. One experience I will be trying this weekend is that at the beginning of Mass people are asked to turn to a neighbor and ask that person to pray for them during the Mass and vice versa. Then at the Prayer of the Faithful all of us will pray for one another as "**Prayer Partners.**" This would be a very simple thing, not complicated, but a way to remember that we don't come to Mass to be alone with God but to be a family that supports one another in finding a connection with Jesus and the Church in a personal way.
