

Answer to the question about the Church Fathers: The Church Fathers were influential theologians, bishops or scholars whose writings

explained key Scriptural principles in the early Church. We unofficially honor them as "fathers" for their proximity to the Apostles, their explanations of Scripture, and their ability to teach the Catholic faith. There are four general categories: Apostolic (directly influenced by the Apostles), Greek (Eastern) Fathers, Latin (Western) Fathers, and the Desert Fathers.
