Work on the installation of our new HVAC System continues daily, Monday thru Friday. All of the equipment needed for the installation has arrived. The work is scheduled to be completed by Oct. 30th.

I thank all the parishioners who have contributed to our two year cathedraticum free HVAC Campaign to raise the funds for the \$630,000 cost of the new system. As of September 12th, we have received \$169,210.50. Parishioners' gifts, combined with the \$50,000 from our reserve fund, gives us a total of \$219,210.50 or 35% towards our goal of \$630,000!

I also thank my brother Knights of Columbus of the South County Council #8251 for their recent raffle which raised \$5,000 for the HVAC Campaign. The three winning ticket numbers from the raffle are in this week's bulletin.

Deacon Doug's Q&A

QUESTION: Thanks to the internet, there are many sources of information about the Church and the Catholic faith available online. Can you identify three sources? (Hint, one of them is available free through the parish).

Answer to the question about sacramentals: Sacramentals are sacred signs resembling the sacraments, set apart or blessed by the church to inspire piety and devotion. They can be channels of actual grace, forgiveness of venial sins, and protection from evil spirits. Examples include the sign of the cross, holy water, holy medals and images and blessings of many kinds. Sacraments were instituted directly by Christ while sacramentals were instituted by Christ through His church. Sacramentals should never take the place of sacraments.
