Dear Brothers and Sisters, Sept. 21st & 22nd

This weekend we hear God, through a prophet from Old Testament times, Amos, speak about people from the Jewish community, of which he was a part, forgetting the poor and being too concerned with making money. So, he says some say **“When will the new moon be over so that we can sell our grain?”** The **“new moon”** would have been a phase of the moon during which, in the ancient Jewish community, no commercial activity would happen, but people would devote themselves to prayer. Then again, Amos says they cheat people in the selling of their grain – even cheating the poor – fixing the scales so that people get less than what seems to be measured, out, etc., etc.

In our own time, we too need to watch out that we don't forget the poor. By the poor we don't just mean the materially poor, but the lonely, the vulnerable (like the unborn, children, and the elderly) and those who are marginalized in some way. But anyway, our lives can't just be about planning ways to make our own selves happy. No, sometimes God calls us to help those in need instead. Today the Prophet Amos, born about 750 B.C., does the honor. So, let's have fun and think of ways to enjoy our family and friends, but let's also remember those who are poor – in very many different ways – in our world today.

**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:** THE **SECOND** COLLECTION ON THE **SECOND** WEEKEND OF EVERY MONTH, STARTING THE WEEKEND OF OCTOBER 12th-13th will be for **THE DRIVEWAY FUND**. Most parishioners know that we have acquired the whole corner of Davidsonville Road and Central Avenue. Envelopes will be in your packets, on the tables in the Narthex. **Those parishioners using Faith Direct will also be able to give electronically.**

We have also let it be known that we are building a driveway, a second entrance/exit for the Holy Family parking lot. It will come into our property off of Davidsonville Road and into our campus. It will also be accompanied by a large amount of plantings to shield residents near that driveway from light and noise. Most people also know that we have acquired the whole corner of Davidsonville Road and Central Avenue, and we plan, in that corner area, to create a grassy area over a section of it that could serve as a playing field. The projected time for beginning that driveway construction is some time between the Fall of 2020 and the early Spring of 2021.

Between now and that time, we are hoping to put aside funds to pay for the creation of the developed greenspace and the driveway on our campus. One way we hope to do this is to have a specific special collection **EACH MONTH** that will go entirely towards building this driveway. This second collection, beginning in October, will be on the **SECOND** weekend of each month. If you can try to remember, then, to be generous to this second collection each month, it would be a great help to our parish.

**DEACON DOUG'S Q & A:** *This week's question:* In the 4th Century, St. Cyril of Jerusalem wrote the following: "When you approach, place your left hand as a throne beneath your right, as befits one who is about to receive the King." What was he describing?

**Answer to last week's question about lighting the candles on the sides of the altar before the offertory.** The candles on either side of the altar are lit to signify that the focus of the Liturgy has shifted from the Liturgy of the Word, where one candle has been lit by the Ambo, to the Liturgy of the Eucharist. The 1963 Constitution of the Sacred Liturgy clearly states that there are the two principal parts of the Mass: the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist. In the first, we listen to the Scripture readings of the day. In the second, after praying the Eucharistic Prayer, we receive the risen Lord in Holy Communion.






