*Dear Brothers and Sisters,  
October 20th & 21st*

This October, in fact in a special way in the homilies this weekend, we'll be talking about **"Respect for Life"** and how our Catholic Christian faith causes us to always remember the dignity of human beings in how we look at our world. We continue to participate in the 40 days for life prayer vigil of love in Annapolis at Planned Parenthood and next to the Pregnancy Center, which tries to help individuals and couples with assistance in the midst of a crisis pregnancy. We are giving out information on Domestic Violence in the bulletin this weekend.

This Sunday after the 11am Mass, there will be a security meeting in Unity Hall for all parishioners to learn how to react in the event of a crisis here at Holy Family. The AAC Police Department is assisting us at this meeting. A light lunch will be provided and the meeting should be around 2 hours. Attending this event might just save the life/lives of a brother or sister, so please try to attend!

Finally, we have a group forming in the parish which I have worked behind the scenes for a while. I am going to let you know about a ministry which is starting for the larger Catholic community in the Annapolis area. It is a ministry to families who have young adult children (18-40) who are Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender (LGBT). This all started in June when some folks asked if they could have a ministry for the benefit of Catholic LGBT young adults and their families.

I know this is a controversial topic: That is why we contacted our local Auxiliary Bishop, Bishop Mark Brennan, for advice.

**Through some conversation, we came up with the following:**

- A.** There is value in having this ministry and it is happening elsewhere in the Archdiocese.
- B.** This ministry can't be **—explicitly or implicitly—** be seen as going against Church teaching.
- C.** This is a ministry to help all involved grow as Catholics.

To this end, we plan to make sure that this group is a place of welcome, but I am also going to be a part of the ministry to help to deal with any potential issues or discussions that we have. At this point the date set to begin is November 7th at 7pm in classrooms 12 & 13 with the parents and young people gathering together and then having break-out sessions. We are also looking into some kind of study on the Bible or the Catholic faith to use as part of the program.

The group is called **"LGBT CATHOLIC OUTREACH MINISTRY OF GREATER ANNAPOLIS."** In planning this group with our parishioners, we have stayed in contact with Bishop Brennan about all of this regularly and even discussed this idea at the monthly meeting of the Bishop with the pastoral leaders of the Anne Arundel County Catholic parishes in September and October (it has support across the county) and plan to continue the discussion with other parishes about how to best support a ministry to LGBT Catholic young adults and their families.

Having said all the above, we plan to create an environment where people feel **welcome and loved**. The ministry will encourage members to be respectful of Church teaching on homosexuality and will try to have respectful, constructive dialogue within the group.

So, we hope that you can pray for this ministry. LGBT youth are 300% more likely to contemplate suicide than youth overall, and since maybe this group can help some of our young adults and families to have a stronger walk with Jesus, perhaps you can pray for this effort.

I hope you can keep this new group in prayer, and know that Bishop Brennan is supportive of our initiative.

We'll eventually be posting contacts for this group and further information, but I wanted to get the word out on this now.




