*Dear Friends,*

This weekend at the 11am Mass, we are reading names of those who have died through our parish in the last year. I am also going to be sharing a little information about our finances in the parish besides speaking on the readings.

The readings this weekend talk about the end of time. They speak of what will happen when Jesus is about to return in glory.

Certainly, that kind of event can seem very far away from us as we commute and raise families and just try to live our lives....but maybe thinking about **"the end of time"** isn't such a remote thing for us after all. It **WOULD BE** a good thing to break out of our routine now and then to realize that everything in life does change, that nothing lasts forever and, remembering to pin our hopes and our aspirations on **SOMETHING THAT WILL LAST, "Faith, God and Our Savior"** ....rather than ignoring God and focusing on so many things that will eventually pass.

The other day I sat with a parishioner who is about my age, 53. We played the beginnings of 100 songs from **"back in the day"** 70's and 80's. It was funny how I knew all the songs but then also how long ago that all seems now....since school dances where we played the Commodores and Kansas and a bunch of other bands you never hear on the radio anymore. That reminded me that how some things will pass but our faith and our God will never pass! Let's take the time to pull away from the **"things of today"** so that we can foster our faith, and foster our relationship with Jesus.
