Feast of Corpus Christi

The Body and Blood of Christ



Introduction:

What would happen if we had no food or anything to drink? Together they keep us alive, and without their life giving nourishment we would die. Jesus is the bread of life who shares himself with us in a special way during the mass.

OPENING PRAYER



Light a Candle and say this prayer:

As we light our candles today, we thank God the Father for sending Jesus, his son, to rescue us from sin, and the Holy Spirit who will always be our friend.

GOSPEL:

MARK 14:22-24

Jesus and his disciples had gathered to celebrate the Passover meal together. While they were eating, Jesus took some bread, gave thanks to his heavenly father, broke the bread, and gave a piece to each of his disciples, saying, "Take this and eat it, this is my body." Then he took a cup of wine. Again he praised his father, and passed it to each of his disciples saying, "Take this and drink it, this is my blood, poured out for you. Do this in memory of me."





Discussion

What joyful event were Jesus and the disciples celebrating at the Last Supper?

Every year the Jewish families and friends gather together to share a meal that celebrates the Passover, when they remember how God freed them from slavery in Egypt. At the Last Supper Jesus shared a loaf of bread and a cup of wine with his friends. He changed the bread and wine into his own body and blood, to nourish them with its life-giving power.


What happens when we celebrate the Mass together?

At our celebration of the eucharist, which means “thanksgiving”, we remember the meal which Jesus shared with his friends the night before he died; and we share in his death and resurrection.
